



JOHN BAPST MUSICIANS EARN HONORS

Bangor, Maine.....John Bapst Memorial High School Fine Arts Director Al McIntyre has announced the names of four students who have received multiple musical honors this year.

John Frankland '09 of Orrington, John Bapst's Senior Cellist, has been selected for the 2009 All-Eastern Honors Orchestra, Classical All-State Orchestra, and the Maine Music Educators District V Honors Festival Orchestra. The All-Eastern Honors Orchestra consists of 150 instrumentalists who will rehearse for three days before their performance in Providence, RI on March 15, 2009.

Kate Fogler '10 of Orrington has been selected for the District V Honors Festival Band, for the Classical All-State Band, and as lead trombonist for the All-State Jazz Band. Lucas Hubbard '10 of Holden has been selected for the Classical All-State Band and as lead trumpet player for the All-State Jazz Band. Chad Ryder '11 of Levant has also been selected for the District V Honors Orchestra as well as for the classical All-State Orchestra on violin.

McIntyre remarked recently on the significance of these achievements. "Selection to one of the All-State bands or choruses in any one year is significant in its own right, but selection of four students to multiple groups in one year is just remarkable. It's an acknowledgement and a public recognition that these young musicians are really exceptional."

In addition to Frankland and Ryder, three other students have been selected for the District V Honors Orchestra: Adriana Pelligrini '11 of Holden, Mary Carmack '12 and Molly Joyce '12 of Veazie. In addition to Fogler, six other students were selected for the District V Honors Band: Lyndsey Brozyna '09 and Lindsey Johndro '09 of Orrington; Mary DeLorenzo '10 of Levant; Dan Honeycutt '10 and Ryan Lad '09 of Glenburn; and Lydia Horne '09 of Holden. Selected for the District V Honors Chorus were Luke Edwards '09 and Nicole Holland '10 of Glenburn; Angela Frankland '11, Laura Jordan '11, and Tom Kenny '11, of Orrington; Kristen Weed '12 of Eddington; Mike Keim '10 and Sarah VanKirk '11 of Veazie; Michael Lalime '09, Molly Moreshead '10, and Matt Ryan '09 of Holden; and Laura Simonds '10 of Brewer. In addition, Nadine Nicke '10 of Glenburn was also selected for the All-State Jazz Band rhythm section on guitar, and tenor Andrew Babbitt '11 of Hampden was selected for the Classical All-State Chorus.
